


# **Itinerary**

#### DAY 1 – September 21th / ARRIVE IN SANTA MARIA NAVARRESE, SARDINIA

Arrive in Olbia or Cagliari airport and take a private transfer to Santa Maria Navarrese (2.5-hour transfer, 160km / 99 miles) or arrive at Olbia International Airport (OLB) for a private transfer to your hotel (2.5-hour transfer, 150km / 93 miles). The hamlet of Santa Maria Navarrese is a renowned seaside resort surrounded by olive, fig, locust, and lotus trees. Meet your English-speaking local guide for a trip briefing.

#### Accommodation: 4-star Hotel in Santa Maria Navarrese



DAY 2 – September 22<sup>th</sup> / DAY AT THE BEACH AND VISIT TO BAUNEI WITH SHEPHERD DINNER

Guided hop-on-hop-off jeep tour of the Baunei mountains, visiting natural and archaeological sites like Su sterru (the deepest chasm in Europe) and shepherd's huts. Enjoy a typical 4-course dinner made by a local shepherd before a jeep transfer back to your hotel.

## DAY 3 – September 23rd/ HIKE: GINNURCU TO PORTO PEDROSU, PORTO QUAU

Hike along 200-meter cliffs overlooking the sea. From Capo Monte Santu, the hike continues to two beautiful fjords, Portu Pedrosu and Portu Quau. Return by boat to Santa Maria Navarrese. (6 hours hiking, 7.5km, 404' ascent, 2,854' descent.)

# DAY 4 – September 24<sup>th</sup> / BOAT DAY AND LUNCH IN GROTTA DEL FICO

Spend the day at sea with stops for swimming and exploration of the spectacular Grotta del Fico, a remote cave along the limestone cliffs of the Gulf of Orosei. Enjoy a packed lunch by the sea.

# DAY 5 – September 25<sup>th</sup> / KAYAKING DAY AND WINE TASTING

Explore the Gulf of Orosei by kayak, navigating hidden sea caves and beautiful coastal scenery. End the day with a wine tasting of local Sardinian varieties.

# DAY 6 – September 26<sup>th</sup> / HIKE: CALA DI LUNA

Hike from Cala Fuili through coastal forests and stunning scenery to Cala Luna. Enjoy cave explorations along the trail and breathtaking views. Return via boat is optional. (4-5 hours of hiking, 7-8 km, 400m elevation.)

## DAY 7 – September 27<sup>th</sup>

#### **Island Excursion by Boat**

Today, enjoy an unforgettable journey cruising along the picturesque shores and idyllic beaches of the La Maddalena archipelago. Come and cruise around the islands, exploring hidden coves and enjoying refreshing swims in the crystal-clear waters. Suspended between the main island of Sardinia and France's Corsica, La Maddelena is an archipelago comprised of seven large islands and 55 tiny islets (isolotti). It features some of the most spectacular beaches in Italy, and some of the cleanest and clearest water. The archipelago takes its name from La Maddalena, its largest island, and from the National Park of which it is the administrative center.
